

● Relevant Government Regulation of the Indonesia Government

- 1) What is the standard used for pre-shipment inspection of Non Hazardous and Non Toxic Waste to Indonesia?
It is based on the Government Regulation of The Republic of Indonesia No. 18 of 1999 on the Management of the Waste of Hazardous and Toxic Materials.
- 2) What is the regulation No.39/M-DAG/PER/9/2009?
In September 02, 2009, the Decree of Minister of Trade of Indonesia issued the regulation No. 39/M-DAG/PER/9/2009 which requires all Non Hazardous and Non Toxic Waste arrived on/after January 01, 2010 to be inspected at the country of origin or the port of loading based on inspection Order Number (ION) from Kerja Sama Operasi (KSO) Sucofindo-Surveyor Indonesia (SCISI) which has been authorized by Indonesian Govt. to perform the technical verification activities.
- 3) Who can conduct the physical inspection and issue the Certificate of Inspection (COI)?
Only the eligible inspection companies which had been selected and formally registered with KSO SCISI can receive the request by importer to perform physical inspection and issue the Certificate of Inspection (COI).
On October 02, 2009, China Certification & Inspection (Group) Co. Ltd. (CCIC), the Head office of CCIC North America Inc. (CCICNA) had been certified by the KSO SCISI as one of the inspection companies that can perform such inspection. As the overseas subsidiary of CCIC in North America, CCICNA is able to provide such physical inspection service in America and Mexico region.
- 4) What types of waste are included under the Non Hazardous and Non Toxic Waste material in accordance to the above mentioned Ministerial Decree?
The types of waste consist of Ferrous/Non Ferrous Metal Scrap, Paper and Carton Waste, Plastic Waste, Rubber Scrap, Culletts and Textile Waste.
- 5) What is the general procedure of applying for the Physical Inspection with KSO?
 - a) After contract has been made between importer and exporter, importer will apply to KSO for Inspection Order Number (ION) based on the PO/Contract between importer and exporter.
 - b) KSO SCISI will issue Verification Order (VO) to importer.
 - c) Importer will give this VO to exporter.
 - d) Exporter will contact the Surveyor which has been appointed/approved by KSO SCISI as their counterpart and arrange for the cargo inspection.
 - e) Exporter shall enclose the Packing List, Invoice, and Exporter's declaration for the Non hazardous and Non Toxic Waste that is going to be shipped.
 - f) After inspection, surveyor will issue the Certificate of Inspection (COI) to the exporter and at the same time send the scan copies to KSO SCISI by email.
